

## Wine and Chocolate to the Rescue Three San Francisco hotels

The name of the package comes from the band Train's hit 2009 album; it's also the name of the band's wine company (savemesanfranciscowineco.com) and a limited-edition chocolate bar line by Ghirardelli (available

at the same website). Proceeds from wine and chocolate sales also benefit Family House.
